5. Suggests a way to stop the spread of the cholera.

# RUBRIC: Meeting the Standard

1. Uses COMPLETE SENTENCES, including capitalization of first word in sentence and proper punctuation.
2. Makes a CLAIM identifying the source of the cholera outbreak.
3. Cites AT LEAST FOUR (4) pieces of EVIDENCE supporting the claim.
4. Uses REASONING to connect AT LEAST THREE (3) pieces of evidence with their claim.
5. Suggests a way to stop the spread of the cholera.

# RUBRIC: Partially Meeting the Standard

1. Uses COMPLETE SENTENCES, including capitalization of first word in sentence and proper punctuation.
2. Makes a CLAIM identifying the source of the cholera outbreak.
3. Cites AT LEAST THREE (3) pieces of EVIDENCE supporting the claim.
4. Does not use REASONING to connect evidence with their claim.

1. Does not use complete sentences.
